Tonight's event is a mix of quiz and map exercise. The first part involves answering questions and doing some maths to give two, 2 digit numbers, which are the easting and northing for a grid square on OS Map 88. The second part involves plotting that grid square and answering a question relating to information in the square.

Part A

Answer the following questions and enter the answers, which are all numbers, as digits in the appropriate place in the 2 grids below.

1. What is Lewis Hamilton's 2020 Formula 1 race car number?
2. How many laps did the 2020 British F1 Grand Prix cover?
3. How many times did Seb Loeb win the WRC Drivers title?
4. For how many consecutive years did David Bogie win the Scottish Rally Championship?
5. On which motorway are Keele Services located?
6. In which year did Jim Clark win his first F1 Drivers title?
7. Which number 1:50,000 scale OS Map covers the Isle of Man?
8. What is the road number of Newcastle's Central Motorway?
9. What was Stirling Moss' start number when he won the 1955 Mille Miglia?
10. Complete the name of Peugeot's first Group B rally car. The 205T??
11. What were the digits in the registration number of Colin McRae's 1995 RAC Rally winning Subaru Impreza?
12. How many wheels did the Williams FW08B racing car have?

Then work through the mathematical exercise to give a 2 digit number at the end of each grid. Work your way across each grid, doing each line from left to right, making each calculation in order.

Eg $6 + 4 / 2 - 3 \times 5$ would equal 10

Part B

Plot the two numbers as an easting and northing onto OS Map 88 to guide you to a grid square.

In that grid square is a farm.
