

Sporting Challenge Regulations 2022-2023

1. The Championship is open to all fully elected members of Whickham & District Motor Club.
2. The Championship will consist of 2 elements: Category 1. A Club calendar covering all organised events where a CoE/ Permit has been issued: eg club night navigational events, 12 Car rallies, Autotests, and Autosolos. Category 2." Flexi events" to reward members competing on driving events outside the club calendar and organised by other clubs, eg Road Rallies, Navigational Rallies, Historic Rallies, Targa Rallies, Reliability Trials, Sprints, Hillclimbs, Autotests, Autosolos, Autocross etc (but excluding special stage rallies).
3. Where WDMC are specifically invited to an event either as a named club or through an Association, members must show WDMC(or an acceptable variation of) as their club on the entry list to score points. Where members are not specifically invited to an event and have to join the organising club or as a member club of an invited Association to be able to enter, WDMC members will be able to claim points for that event, subject to them being a fully paid up member of WDMC at the time of the start of the event.
4. Points will be awarded to competitors based on their finishing position relative to other WDMC Competitors. The highest placed WDMC competitor in the events overall classification will score 12 points, 2nd placed WDMC Competitor 10 points, 3rd – 8 points, 4th – 6 points, 5th – 5 points, down to 1 point for the 9th placed and below. No more than 2 members of each team (or crew) can claim points in the Club Championship for each event. The organisers of each event will also be awarded 3 points(subject to 2 organisers – 1.5 points each).
5. The number of scores to count will be all events in the club calendar.
6. Separate Championship records will be maintained for drivers, navigators (experts)and novice drivers. Novices to be determined by Competition Secretary.
7. Awards will be presented at the end of the year to the highest placed and runner up driver and navigator and subject to eligibility, the highest placed novice driver and navigator in the points table.
8. Points will be awarded by the Competition Secretary and members must advise the Competition Secretary where they have competed on an event and provide a copy of the event entry list or results. THE ONUS IS AT ALL TIMES ON THE COMPETITOR TO PROVIDE THESE DETAILS. Points will not be awarded retrospectively, ie a competitor may not claim any points for an event that has taken place before they paid their membership fee for the current membership period. The competition secretary may at times be advised of relevant results from"flexi" events by other means, but the onus at all times is on the competitor to report any errors or omissions to the competition secretary within 14 days of results being declared final. Club positions may be available at any club night and displayed regularly on the club website Pacenotes and Facebook.
9. Results to be compiled by the Competition secretary and forwarded on to the Webmaster and Magazine Editor for publication.
